

# Self-Watering Container Quick-Start Guide



Keep your container assembled as shown. Fill the growing chamber with soil, keeping the ends of the wicking rope sticking up into the soil.



Plant your seeds according to the instructions on the packet and *lightly* top-water the soil to get it damp. Put a protective cover over your container if you choose.



Fill and refill the reservoir *from the side down one of the vertical grooves*.

Do not top-water the soil often or you will strip the nutrients out of the soil and create sediment in the reservoir.

**ONLY WATER BY REFILLING THE RESERVOIR!**



Stop putting in water once you see water coming out of the drain hole.

Top off the water in your reservoir once or twice a week until your seeds sprout.

Depending on what you are growing, you may need to refill the reservoir more frequently once your plants get big and start making fruits and vegetables.
